Arrival

Welcome and registration

When you arrive onsite please enter through the main showground gates. To confirm each team member has arrived on site, in line with our safeguarding plan, we will be checking tickets and ID at the gate.

Tickets: You will need to show your Tito ticket with the QR code either on your phone or printed out on paper. Team tickets with the QR code will be re-emailed out the week before the event.

ID: Please can we ask that you **bring 1 form of photo ID, either a driving license, passport or ID with the pass mark on it. Please follow the stewards who will direct you to registration when you arrive.**

We are aware that there may be train strikes happening on Friday 28th July, so please do double check if you are planning to arrive via train.



This year at DTI we are going to have wristbands for each delegate on site. These wristbands will have a QR code that will link to each delegate or team member's tickets. The wristbands will help with the safeguarding of each individual on site. Additionally, they will enable us to be able to scan delegates on and off site, in and out of venues, and in the case of emergency scan a wristband to see if there is an indicator to suggest that this individual may have a medical condition. The wristbands will be given out as team arrive on site.

Cashless

The wristbands also have an added functionality of offering cashless payments onsite at DTI. There will have the option to buy vouchers online ahead of arrival at DTI that will then be linked to your wristband. Alternatively, you can top up your wristband using cash or card at the Info Desk or in the DTI Hub when you arrive onsite.

Team will have all of their meals catered for, and snacks and drinks provided throughout the day so there is no need to add money to your wristbands. You will only need to add money to your wristband if you would like to buy merchandise, food from the cafes or food vans onsite.

Vehicle Access

After you have completed your ID check you will be able to drive down to the Yellow team campsite, where you will be allocated a camping pitch. Cars can be driven down to Yellow in compliance with the **showground speed limit of 10 mph.** Cars can be parked on site for **2 hours** whilst they are unloaded and then must be moved to the carpark across the road. Cars **cannot** be kept on the Yellow campsite. The carpark will be manned 24/7, and the underpass must be used to re enter the showground. Please follow the signs and stewards to get to the carpark once you have unpacked your car.

If you are staying in a motorhome/caravan you are welcome to drive this down to the yellow campsite and pitch it there. Once the motorhome/caravan has been pitched it cannot be moved until departure day.

Blue Badge Holders

If you are a blue badge holder you will be able to keep your car onsite in a designated parking space.

Friday All Team Welcome Meeting

We would love to invite all team members to join us on Friday night (19:30-21:00) for an all team welcome meeting with prayer and worship in the Dream Cafe. This will be a time to connect with each other, hear from Susie, Zeke and the Core Team and get equipped for the week ahead. Please let us know if you won't be able to arrive on time for the meeting.



Accommodation

Camping

The majority of team will be camping on the yellow campsite. The yellow campsite is divided into a number of camping zones that you will be directed to by a campsite host on arrival day. (See map at the bottom of the pack).

Team will have access to their own toilets and showers on the yellow campsite.

Additionally, team only showers are also available between 07:00-08:30 each morning in the Bingley Hall. Team will need to access these from the main entrance to Bingley Hall.

Camping with a Youth Group

If you would like to camp with your church youth group then you will need to seek permission from your churches lead youth leader. They will need to ensure that you follow their churches safeguarding processes. If they are happy for you to camp with them then we will provide them with a campsite pass to give to you when they check in on Friday.

Noise Curfew

All of the venues will close at 23:30 each day, and we ask that the site is quiet by 00:00. Please respect other team members, some of whom may have young children camping in the team area.

Night Stewards

We have a wonderful team of night stewards who will be awake all night taking care of the site. Please could we ask that you are mindful that they will be sleeping in the Yellow campsite (as much as they can) in the mornings and early afternoon each day.

Campshop

We will have a camping shop onsite in The Station selling lots of camping essentials such as tents, tent poles, sleeping bags, toothbrushes, air beds etc

Staying Offsite

If you are staying offsite, we would ask that you park in the carpark opposite the showground each day when you arrive on site. You will then need to use the underpass walk to and from the showground.

If you are a blue badge holder you will be able to park your car onsite in a designated parking space.



Food & Drink

Breakfast, lunch and dinner will be available each day for the team free of charge in the team lounge (there will be a big flag outside to direct you!!)

Breakfast - 07:30 - 09:00

Lunch -12:30-14:00

Dinner - 16:30 -18:30

You will need to bring your team lanyard with you in exchange for breakfast lunch and dinner each day. To reduce the queues at meal times (lunch and dinner only) teams will be allocated meal slots within the serving times. Your team leader will let you know when your team are eating. If you have under 11's with you, they will also eat with you in the dining room during the designated meal time for your team.

We recommend that you bring with plenty of snacks with you in case you need extra food outside of the meal times. We also recommend bringing a water bottle so that you can stay hydrated.

Cafes, Onsite Shop and Food Vans

We have a range of cafes, shops and food vans selling food onsite. These will be open every day for you to purchase additional drinks and snacks throughout the week.

DTI operates a zero tolerance approach to alcohol on site. We ask that no team members bring or consume alcohol on site at DTI

Rotas/ Communications

You will receive your team rotas and be introduced to your team leader a few weeks before DTI. Your team leader will be your first point of contact if you have any queries before or during the event.

Dream Kids

If your child is aged 0-11 then we can't wait to welcome them to Dream Kids this year! We've got a packed programme filled with worship, teaching, games, crafts, sports, ministry time and more.

Registration for Dream Kids is open between 15:00-16:00 on Saturday afternoon in the Kids 5-11 venue.

If you're camping with a tiny human, you deserve a gold star. We'd love to help make things a little easier for you by providing warm water and tubs for you to get your baby clean before bed time. Please bring your own towels and toiletries to the Dream Kids 0-4s venue.

Team Illness

We really hope that all team members are well onsite throughout the week. If you become unwell throughout the week and are unable to serve on your rota please contact your team leader at the start of your shift to let them know that you are unwell. We would ask that all team members who are feeling unwell and unable to serve to remain in their tents. Your team leader will then inform Control who will let the first aid team know.

Team Lounge

There will be a team lounge on site for team to hang out in each day when you are not on rota. The team lounge is in the Ingestre Suite (where your meals will be served) and will be open between 7.30am - 11.00pm. There will be free hot drinks, snacks, games and some comfy seats for you to hang out in.

Teams Pastors

This year we are really pleased to announce that Nigel and Jo Hemming are going to be joining us as Teams Pastors. We recognise that team are working really hard on site and sometimes need a little bit of extra support and encouragement and prayer. Nigel and Jo will be checking up on teams throughout the week and will be based in the Team Lounge.

Heading Offsite

Team are permitted to leave site when they are not serving, but please do make sure to get back in plenty of time for your next shift.

Departure

We will need all team to stay and help setdown DTI on the morning of Thursday 3rd August. We anticipate that all team will be offsite by late morning before we handover the showground at 12:00

The cards on lanyard this year not only have your team name on it, but also show which teams have been trained to pray for young people and if they have access to the certain zones such as youth campsites, connect, prayer and chat areas. These teams members will have a blue background. Those that don't will have the standard DTI red.
