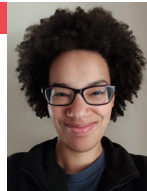
ABS NIBLOCK

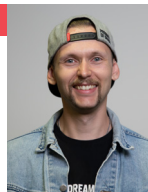


JOEL HARRIS

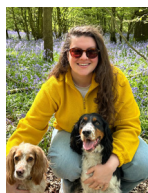
JON SOLWAY
